A **code word or phrase** is something your family agrees on in advance that means:

- "This is serious pay attention" Example: My face fills hot
- "Something's wrong you need to act" Example: I forgot to feed the fish
- "This person is safe to go with" (in case someone other than a parent is picking a child up)

 - Pineapple Grandma's Cookies
 - Blue Giraffe Captain Banana
